Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Privacy Policy applies to www.kenoshapublicmarkets.org / www.kenoshapublicmarkets.com and Kenosha Public Market (collectively referred to as “KPM”), and governs all data collection and usage by KPM. The KPM website's purpose is to communicate who we are and what we do as a nonprofit organization. By using the KPM website, you hereby consent to the data practices described in this policy.

Collection of Your Personal Information

KPM may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

Name, Mailing Address and Email Address.

If you purchase KPM's products and services, we collect your billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete your purchase transaction.

KPM encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from KPM so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. KPM is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the KPM website.

Use of Your Personal Information

KPM collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

KPM may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from KPM and its affiliates. KPM may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinions of current services or potential new services that may be offered.

KPM does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

KPM may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (name, email address, mailing address, telephone number) will not be

transferred to the third party. KPM may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personally identifiable information except to provide those services to KPM, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

KPM will disclose your personally identifiable information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on KPM or affiliates; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of KPM; and (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of KPM, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by KPM. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the services offered by KPM, to maintain quality of said services, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the KPM website.

Use of Cookies

The KPM website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize KPM pages, or register with a KPM site or services, a cookie helps KPM to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personally identifiable information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and related information. When you return to the same KPM website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the KPM features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser settings to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the KPM services or websites you visit.

Security of Your Personal Information

KPM secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. KPM uses the following methods for this purpose:

SSL Protocol and Authorize.net for Encrypted Website Payments

When your personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.

Children Under Thirteen

KPM does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use the KPM website.
